In the beginning, Eva told wild and wonderful stories to her brother, but over time, and as the hardships mounted, she stopped telling stories. When teenagers, they were adopted by Bob and Maria who are kind and loving in every way, but Eva could never bring herself to fully trust them. Eva and Jack remained close, but she only visited for the major holidays and never stayed long. Being around Jack's healthy family highlighted all she had lost. Eva struggles with thoughts that she will always be broken and odd. But the reality is, she's a genius. Eva's stories become a source of healing not just for the Keating children, but for herself as well, as they all discover the strength that can only be found in family.
